



Your wristband is the **only** thing that signifies that you are valid member of D Riddim Tribe for 201 ! If you don't have this, **you will be thrown out of the band!**

For Masqueraders, Fun Mas, Premium and Drinks Inclusive, you will need to be wearing your wristband to get drinks - there will be no exceptions! If you are seen to be giving your drinks to members of the public or T-shirts who don't have inclusive drinks in their package you may be asked leave the band and banned from joining again next year.

Costume members and Premium members will also have a wristband which will be removed from the exchange for your meal when we eat. A light breakfast will be provided for **Costume Masqueraders Only**.

SECURITY - 2 MUSIC TRUCKS. (1st Truck)
The sections will be Costumes, Funmas and T-shirt sections with specifics to be published soon. We have tight security on the Monday with a licensed security firm. Anyone without a wristband will be removed from the band regardless if they are wearing a T-shirt or costume. Please do not encourage people to come within the ropes as they will be thrown out of the band however you can join them outside of the ropes; if you fail to comply you will not be joining the band next year. We request your full co-operation with security as they are there for your safety. Any abuse to the security and you will be asked to leave the band.

NO UNAUTHORISED PERSONS ON THE TRUCK

We have been restricted in the number of vehicles we have on the road, so there is no rest truck for the drunk, injured or can't keep up masqueraders. We want you to enjoy yourselves, wear comfortable shoes, please take care of yourselves and each other and **know your limits!** If you are seen to be over intoxicated you will no longer be served any drinks.

If anyone is in need of assistance, they will be shown to the nearest A & E Stand along the carnival route as **they will not be allowed to rest on the music or drinks truck!** Please note that no one will be allowed access on to the music truck at anytime unless they have been issued with a truck pass. Due to health and safety we can only allow 10 truck pass holders on at any one time.

PLEASE BE AWARE YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO LEAVE BAGS ON THE TRUCK.

BEHAVIOUR - Lastly we will **NOT** tolerate any rude or abusive behaviour towards anyone in the band or the public. If you are seen to be doing this you will be asked to **LEAVE D RIDDIM TRIBE** and banned from joining again.

Please note for Children's day Sunday

All children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian over 18.

When booking you fully accepted that you will be solely responsible for the child(ren) the costume(s) or T-shirt(s) purchased for on Carnival Sunday 26th August 2018. D Riddim Tribe will not take responsibility for lost or unprotected children. We will have ropes, stewards and security volunteers on the day to make sure everyone overall is ok.



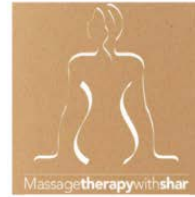

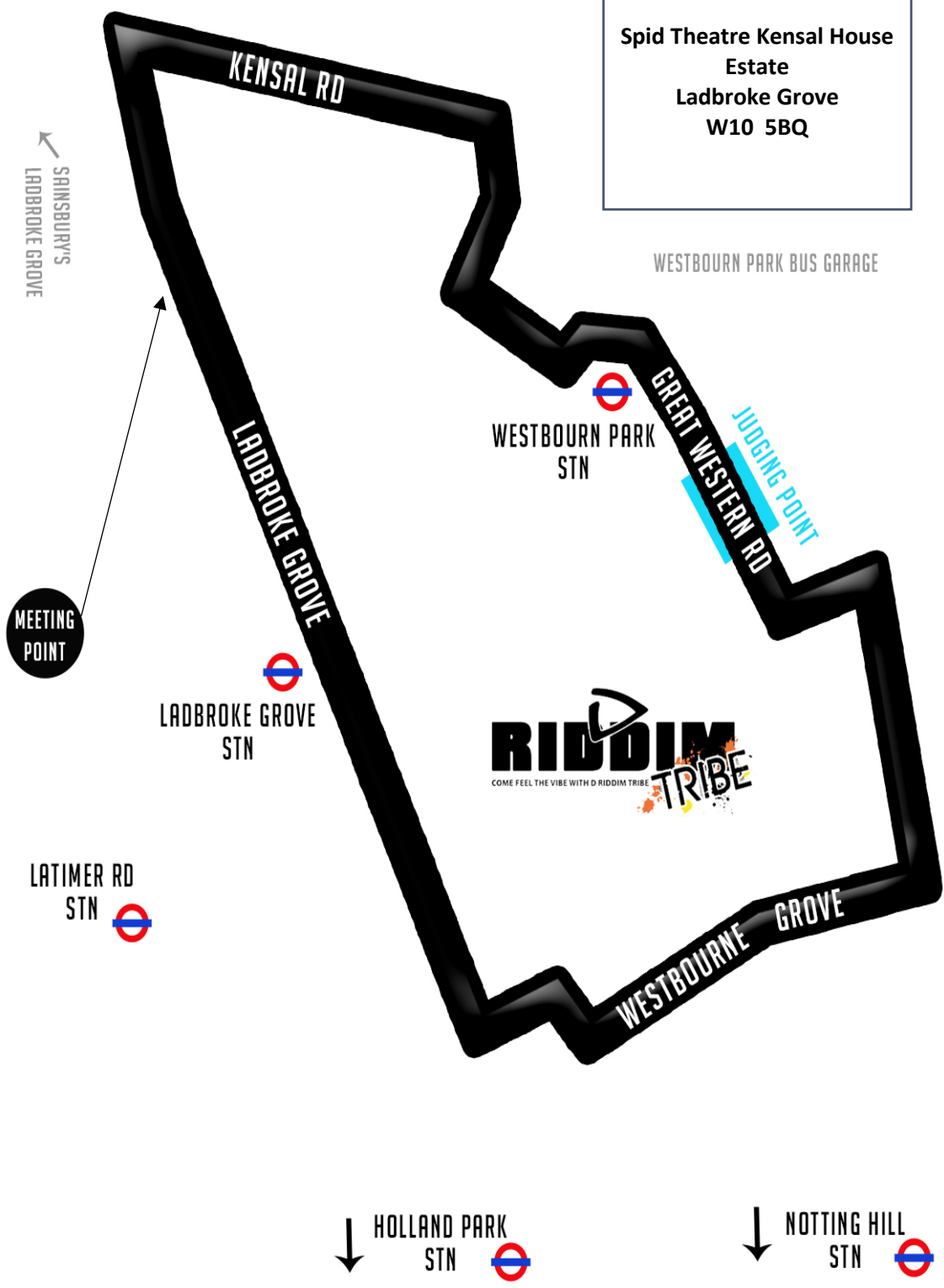
